REAL POWER LOSSES Shirley Buckmier (lead)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For Transmission Contract Holders for BPA Power Business Line purchases with losses bundled in the price, the ability to have a loss provider other than the PBL for other transmission contracts. • Concurrent and/or financial losses • Frequency customers may change loss providers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Possibility of designating loss providers by schedule (E-tag) • Reconciliation of losses
WIND SCHEDULING TBL rep TBD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wind/intermittent generation scheduling 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Alternatives for scheduling • FERC proposal wind generator tied to forecast schedule and settled monthly aggregated amount

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SCHEDULING PRACTICES Lorie Hoffman (Lead) Corene Surface		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passive approval of tags and accepted schedule of tag is not accepted by TBL • Intermediate transfer party included in tag should have say so/deny tag • TBL elimination of “inactive” accounts is a problem • OASIS doesn’t reflect long-term commitments • Contract demand limits between TBL and transmission customer • Reconciliation process behind billings • Concern on system changes • Account building after hours • Internal constrained paths • CASIO supplemental market schedule changes within the hour • ST firm redirects for PTP
BP FORUM STRUCTURE Mike McFarland (Lead) Cathy Ehli		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workgroups tackle issues and bring proposals before the larger group • Workgroups submit meeting notes/reports on progress • Chair of workgroup designated by workgroup • Next large group meeting first week of February • Use progress or workgroups to prioritize issues at next meeting • TBL will organize first workgroup meetings

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OTHER Mike McFarland (Lead) Cathy Ehli		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add customer to TBL decision criteria • How will today's efforts correlate/integrate/support RTO efforts? • All submitted comments will be posted on BP Forum website • WECC is addressing issues that will have trickle-down affect • Where can tech forum contribute to other arenas? • BPA may have different customer needs than CAISO. Are these known and considered? • There is a workgroup within WECC on curtailment (regional standard procedures). Can tech forum contribute recommendations?

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
